Celestia brings an authentic twist to the typical charter experience. The Indonesian yacht, also known as a *phinisi*, was handcrafted using UNESCO-protected methods by the boatbuilders of the Bulukumba district in South Sulawesi, and is steeped in tradition. The 148-footer can comfortably accommodate 14 guests. Over five days, *Celestia* will sail around the Indonesian archipelago, one of the planet's most pristine environments (home to 75 percent of the world's coral species), including Komodo, Raja Ampat, Alor, and the Spice Islands. Numerous excursions and activities are available during the cruise, while food comes courtesy of Michelin-restaurant-trained chef Wayan Kresna Yasa, who spotlights local dishes and delicacies.

Bhasin used the earrings' 15.20 carats of Trapiche emeralds (among the rarest on Earth, notable for their unusual six-armed black-radial inclusions) as inspiration for the jewelry's architecture by placing them at the end of each diamond-accented spoke. Set within 20-karat yellow gold, each stem converges to a center set with tumbled Muzo emeralds, surrounded in black enamel, totaling 5.50 carats for the pair.

Founder and vigneron Loïc Pasquet turned Bordeaux on its head with Liber Pater, his wine named for a Roman god of viticulture. It's made with rare grape varieties such as Castet, Pardotte, Tarnay, and Petite Vidure that existed before the blight of the French wine industry in the mid-1850s due to phylloxera, a disease of the vine caused by an aphid. Because of the intensive labor and farming required, Liber Pater is the most expensive wine in the world upon release, with bottles retailing for over \$52,000 and becoming instant collectibles. This is an opportunity to own vintages from 2007 (the first year Liber Pater was released), 2009, 2011, 2015, 2018, and 2019.

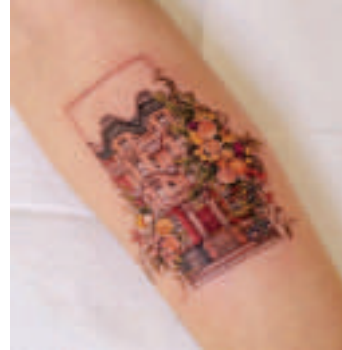
